





PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

As one of UNDP's flagship programmes contributing to the Climate Promise, the NDC Support Programme helps countries advance integrated climate and development solutions through the implementation of the Paris Agreement on Climate Change.

Since its high-level launch in 2017 at the UN Climate Summit (COP23), **the Programme has grown significantly and is currently supporting 41 countries** around the world.


Drawing upon extensive foundational work on low-emission development and NDCs, the Programme is focused on **five key results** underpinned by peer-to-peer knowledge sharing and advocacy efforts:

1. Leadership strengthened and championed to promote ambitious climate change vision;
2. Integrated governance enhanced to deliver NDC outcomes
3. Evidence-based design and planning of mitigation actions delivered;
4. Capacities developed to design climate-friendly investment opportunities, address investor risk, and blend and catalyze climate finance; and
5. Enabling environment enhanced for private sector engagement.

National projects are country driven and implemented; responding to government priorities and support needs.

PROGRAMME SERVICES

The two support areas most in demand under the Programme are **refinement and/or disaggregation of NDC targets and integrated governance**:

- 90% of countries requested support for refinement and/or disaggregation of NDC targets (e.g., reviewing, quantifying and revising targets for enhanced NDCs, preparing NDC implementation plans);
- 85% of countries requested support on strengthening institutional frameworks for NDC implementation, such as establishing formal mechanisms for coordination and data sharing or preparing laws and regulations.

The other work areas drawing most interest from countries are **transparency, private sector engagement, and accessing finance**:

- 61% of countries are strengthening and/or establishing national Measuring, Reporting and Verification (MRV) systems to track NDC implementation and impacts.
- 63% of countries are looking to engage the private sector in a systematic manner.
- 63% of countries are either strengthening the enabling environment and addressing barriers to finance or establishing financial mechanisms.

Gender is a key cross-cutting area of work under the programme. Ten pilot countries began working on gender-responsive NDC implementation and these experiences and impacts inspired an additional 15 countries to include gender-responsive activities.

Meanwhile, the economic and environmental impacts of climate change – further exacerbated by the COVID-19 health pandemic – have generated a groundswell of support for **green recovery** strategies that are **resilient, inclusive, just**, and fully in line with the global goals of the Paris Agreement.
